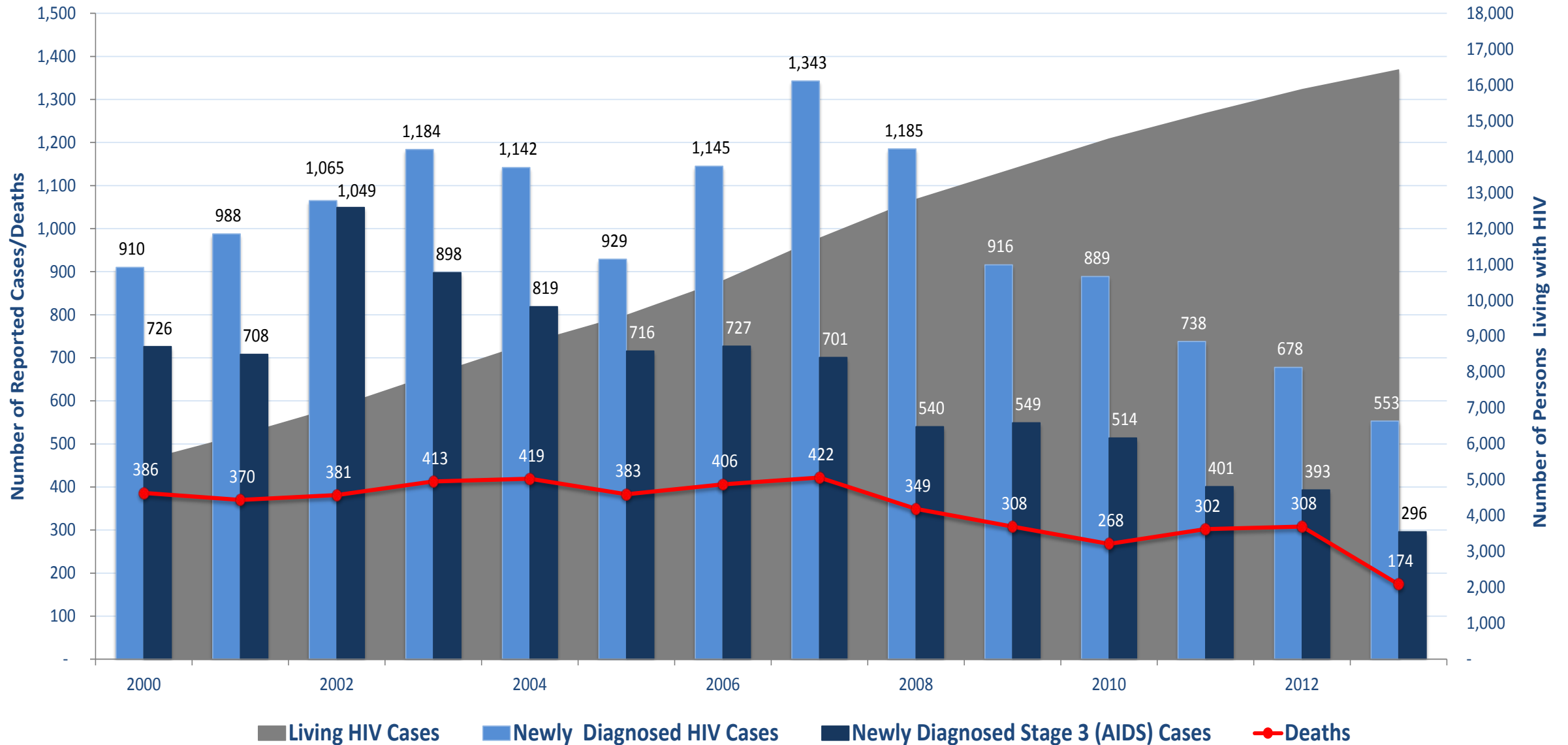
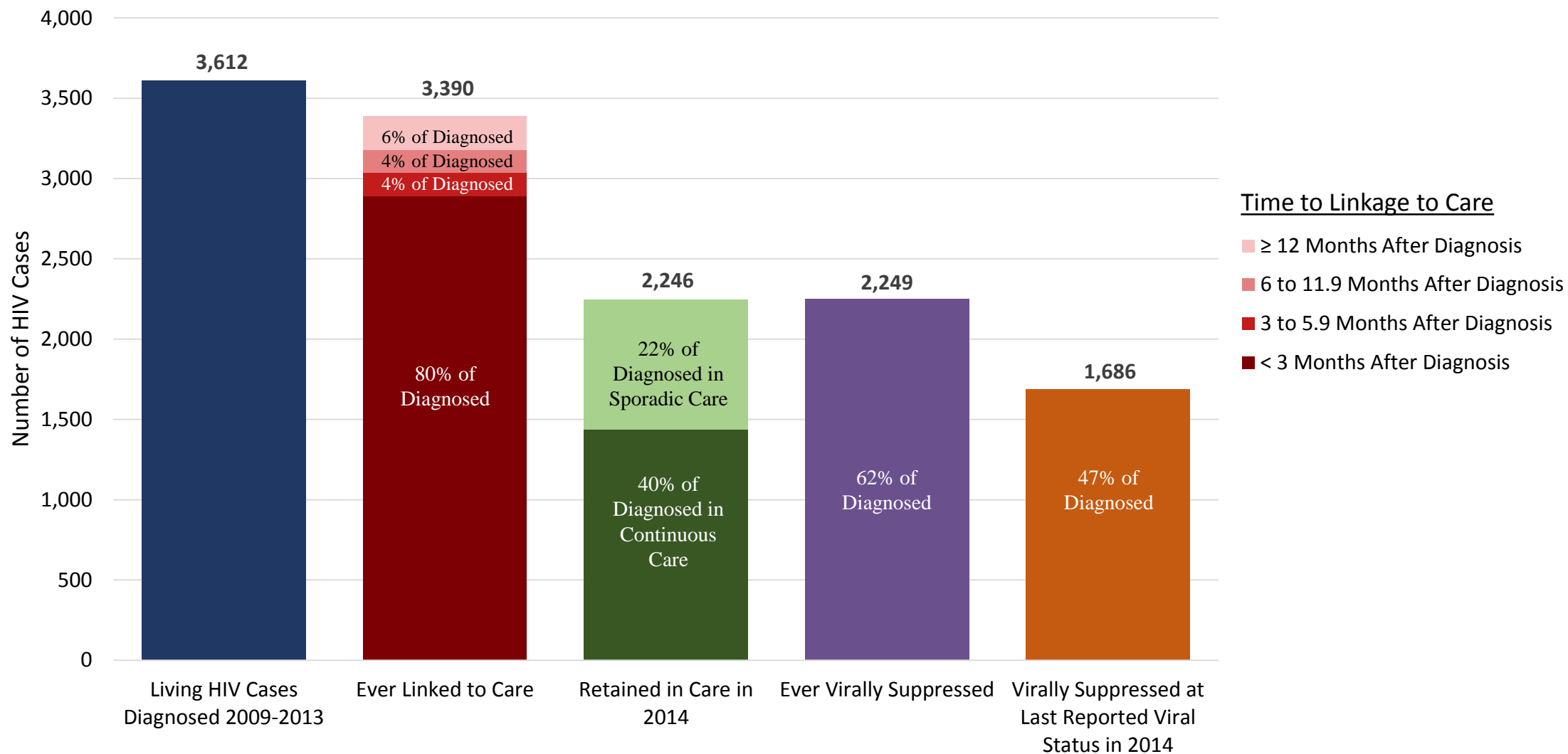


**Figure 1: Trends in Reported HIV/AIDS Diagnoses and Deaths
